REQUIREMENTS

Preamble

General Membership of the Faculty of Travel Medicine is open to all members of The Australasian College of Tropical Medicine (ACTM) who have an interest in Travel Medicine. Applicants for membership of the Faculty may apply using the prescribed form.

Applications for other categories of membership must meet the criteria and will be reviewed by the Board of Censors/Membership Committee. The requirements for membership and maintenance of membership may be subject to change.

All grades

Must be a member (any level) of The Australasian College of Tropical Medicine

Fellowship (FFTM)

- Medical, nursing or equivalent degree qualification from a recognised university or college; AND
- Working, or having worked a min of three years full-time or equivalent part-time in travel medicine, AND
- Evidence of commitment to continuing education in travel medicine; AND
- Submit a recent curriculum vitae, AND
- Be nominated by two (2) professional referees, AND
- Nominated and seconded by two (2) financial members of the College, at least one of whom will be a Fellow of the College or Faculty.
- Have made a significant contribution to travel medicine; AND at least one of:
 - Completed a Postgraduate award in travel medicine from a recognised university or college; OR
 - Pass in a written examination in travel medicine set by an approved organisation; OR
 - Hold Fellowship of the Australasian College of Tropical Medicine or an approved College; OR
 - Have published works related to travel medicine.

Notes/Further information

1. A list of acceptable postgraduate academic qualifications will be maintained by the College (see Appendix 1). Other postgraduate academic qualifications will be assessed on a case-by-case basis.
2. A list of acceptable Fellowships will be maintained by the college, (see Appendix 2). In general, the approved fellowship should be recognised as a specialist qualification. Membership of an approved College or other professional organisation will be considered in the context of other qualifications.
3. The candidate should have made a significant contribution to travel medicine, which will normally be assessed through a documented portfolio of work that may include publications, presentations, involvement in policy and/or guideline development and demonstrating their impact and influence in local and/or international networks.

HONORARY FELLOWSHIP AND HONORARY MEMBERSHIP OF THE FACULTY OF TRAVEL MEDICINE

Nominations may be made by College and Faculty members of persons, institutions and organisations who may meet one of the following criteria for Honorary Fellowship or Honorary Membership of the Faculty of Travel Medicine. Nominations should be made on the prescribed form. Nominations will be reviewed by the Board of Censors of the College and the Awards and Honours Committee of the College and ratified by the College Council.

Honorary Fellowship

- Awarded to persons, who meet the requirements for Fellowship of the Faculty, who have made outstanding contributions in travel medicine.

Honorary Membership

- Awarded to persons, institutions and organisations, who have made significant contributions to travel medicine.

REQUIREMENTS

Preamble

General Membership of the Faculty of Expedition and Wilderness Medicine is open to all members of The Australasian College of Tropical Medicine (ACTM) who have an interest in Expedition and Wilderness Medicine. Applicants for membership of the Faculty may apply using the prescribed form.

Applications for other categories of membership must meet the criteria details in these bylaws. Applications will be reviewed by the Board of Censors/Membership Committee of the ACTM. The requirements for membership and maintenance of membership may be subject to change.

All grades

Must be a member (any level) of The Australasian College of Tropical Medicine

Fellowship (FFTM)

- Medical, nursing or equivalent degree qualification from a recognised university or college; AND
- Working, or having worked a min of three years full-time or equivalent part-time in expedition and/or wilderness medicine, AND
- Evidence of commitment to continuing education in travel medicine that covers scope of expedition wilderness medicine; AND
- Submit a recent curriculum vitae; AND
- Be nominated by two (2) professional referees, one of whom will be a Fellow of the College or Faculty; AND
- Have made a significant contribution to expedition wilderness medicine; AND at least one of:
 - Completed a Postgraduate award in travel medicine that covers the scope of expedition or wilderness medicine, from a recognised university or college; OR
 - Completed a postgraduate award in expedition or wilderness medicine from a recognised university or college; OR
 - Pass in a written examination in expedition or wilderness medicine set by an approved organisation; OR
 - Hold Fellowship of the Australasian College of Tropical Medicine or an approved College; OR

- Have published works related to expedition and wilderness medicine.

Notes/Further information

1. A list of acceptable postgraduate academic qualifications will be maintained by the College (see Appendix 1). Other postgraduate academic qualifications will be assessed on a case-by-case basis.
2. A list of acceptable Fellowships will be maintained by the college, (see Appendix 2). In general, the approved fellowship should be recognised as a specialist qualification. Fellowship and/or Membership of an approved College or other professional organisation will be considered in the context of other qualifications.
3. The candidate should have made a significant contribution to expedition and wilderness medicine, which will normally be assessed through a documented portfolio of work that may include publications, presentations, involvement in policy and/or guideline development and demonstrating their impact and influence in local and/or international networks.

HONORARY FELLOWSHIP AND HONORARY MEMBERSHIP OF THE FACULTY OF TRAVEL MEDICINE
